January 16, 2022 Pierrette said her cousin Todd Melisan has multi-myeloma, a blood cancer. Ann said her niece is still in the hospital – no further information. Monica’s daughter is flying back home; The Potter family now is dealing with COVID. Debbie Blair said Ben likes his new job but with a flu-like illness is to be tested for COVID; Also thankful the new house heating problem is being dealt with. Beth said Jack’s eye surgery went well. Robin and Jonathon have tested positive for COVID – minor symptoms have been experienced.

January 9, 2022 Ann’s niece has been found and is in a hospital—no other word at this time. Barb’s concern is for a cousin who died from COVID complications—a celebration of life is planned; her own stitches are out (of her back) and she is feeling better—though planning for knee replacements later this year. Debbie Blair’s joy is that Ben starts his new job tomorrow. Beth asks prayers for Jack who has eye surgery tomorrow. Chris’ joy is that Jess begins a new job at UMD at the end of the month in speech therapy (Jess also has COVID). Debbie Flook said several family members have COVID, but mild cases; prayers for Gail Zamenski who has melanoma.

January 2, 2022 (Zoom service only) Matt asked Gail if she were feeling well—she is. Debbie Blair relayed a joy from Barb Lang that her son’s friend Rose does have Covid but is doing well—also her weather is quite cold. Miranda shared a concern that Nick (friend from Poolesville) has been dealing with the death of his mother in October and is doing well. Monica was grateful for the ‘staff gift’; and shared that her friend Christen and her husband from Alaska are in Atlanta with their 3month old baby who has covid but just snuffles so far - they are isolating. Plans are to continue with ‘Zoom’ services through January.

December 26, 2021 (Zoom service only) Barb’s concern turned into a joy as a biopsy on her back turned out to not be a problem. Chris said that the 3-year old (with COVID) is doing well and all others are waiting test results. Monica said her daughter and friend are covid-positive and doing well with minimal symptoms. Beth said Deacon has mild symptoms and is awaiting testing; cousin Rachael died on the 23rd of pancreatic cancer. Debbie Blair joy that family was all there for Christmas; Ben begins new job in January. Hugh said they delivered a Christmas meal to family members rather than meeting in person (Gail has strep).
